DreamBox Maths Assignments

Assignments allow teachers to choose targeted concepts to supplement the personalised lessons chosen by the programme. These Assignments can be aligned by the DreamBox Learning Unit or the English National Curriculum.

Scenarios for utilising assignments

Content frontload - To prepare students for an upcoming unit of study, you can:

- Create a 'Short-term' assignment to gather data on students' understanding of upcoming skills and create small groups.
- Create a 'Long-term' assignment for the 2-3 weeks leading up to a module to provide exposure to content and build student confidence.

Content review - To review current or previous content to determine if students can apply their thinking within DreamBox Maths, you can:

- Create a 'Short-term' assignment to gather data on student understanding with the skills from today's lesson.
- Create a 'Long-term' assignment and select 'All lessons in category' to collect data on a culmination of skills from the unit.

Creating Assignments

Locate the Add Assignment button on the Home page of your Dashboard. Alternatively, you can view the 'Assignment History' report of your classroom to create an Assignment.

Select Short-term or Long-term for the Assignment type, and then the year level, category and lesson group. Preview a sample of each level of the Assignment using the 'Preview Lesson' links listed above each group of students. Students will receive the appropriate level of assignment based on their proficiency data within DreamBox Maths.

Ensure that the desired students are selected with the checkboxes and then choose 'Add Assignment'.
