



## How pupils log in

How to guide


To locate login information and Family Access Letters from the Home Page:

- Select the classroom you wish to view in the filters at the top of the page.
- Scroll down to the Roster Management section.


Pupils can log into DreamBox Maths on a laptop, desktop computer or Chromebook in two ways.

- Open an internet browser on your pupil's computer or laptop.
- Navigate to your school's unique DreamBox Maths login web address (URL). When the Math school login page opens it may look like one of the two options below, based on the type of password/s pupils use at the school.

If all pupils use text usernames and passwords, you will see the Username and Password fields only.



If pupils use picture passwords, you will see multiple ways to log in.








## Logging in with a text password

To log in using a text password, enter the pupil's DreamBox Maths username and password and click Log In.

## Logging in with a picture password.

• Enter the pupil's 5-digit numeric classroom code then click Log In.



• When the pupil's classroom page opens, showing pupils' avatars, first names and last initials, the pupil needs to click their name or avatar picture.

Note: If a pupil selects the wrong avatar, they can click the back arrow button in their browser to return to the classroom page and select the correct avatar.







If you see a placeholder image instead of an avatar for a pupil, it means they have not selected it yet. They will be prompted to select an avatar when they log in.

- When the password page opens:
  - If it is the first time a pupil is logging in, the picture they select will be their password going forward.
  - If the pupil has already selected their picture password, they select the picture they chose.



If a pupil has not selected a password, after they select a picture they will be asked to confirm if they want that image to be their password. If not, they can select a different image and confirm their choice.
