Class Reading Progress Report

The Class Reading Progress Report provides a comprehensive picture of the efficiency/fluency gains and reading level gains students have made in the Reading component.







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A red ? is presented if the student's independent reading rate (I-Rate) was significantly faster or significantly slower than the guided rate (G-Rate) throughout the most recent lesson. In other words, the system could not confidently report I-Rate because it was so far outside the student's target zone.

Tip: Consider checking in with the student to ensure the Guided Window is moving at a comfortable pace. If not, you can adjust the G-Rate in Settings.





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• The number outside of the blue progress bar and to the right indicates the level a student must reach to demonstrate mastery of year-level content.
