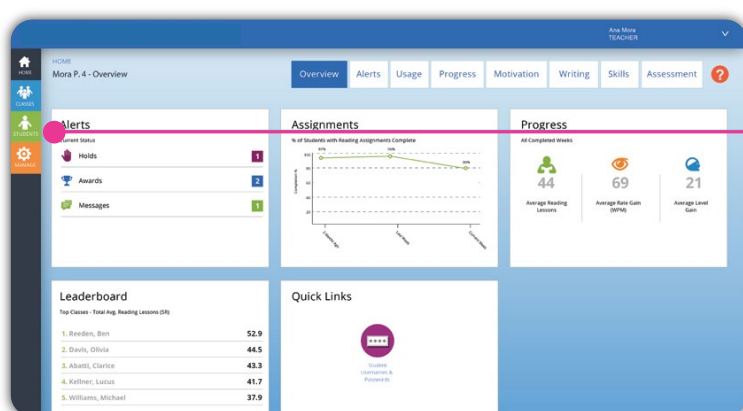


How to adjust assignments for an individual student

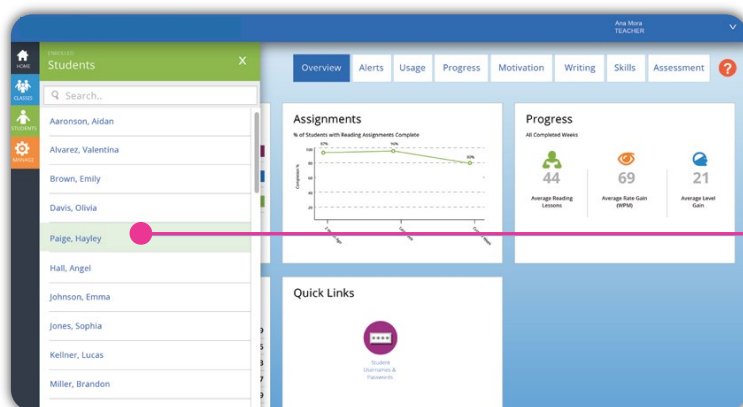

After completion of the initial assessment, Reading Plus recommends assignments to meet each student's needs. Teachers may choose to change Recommended Assignments for an individual student.

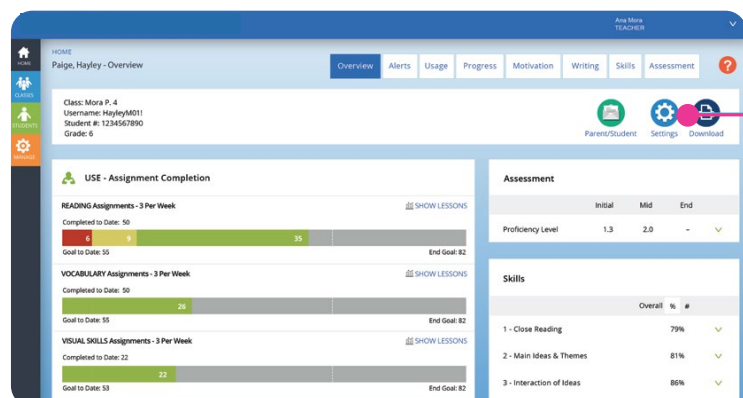
To adjust assignments for an individual student:

Approximate Completion Times per Lesson:
 Reading = ~15 minutes/lesson
 Vocabulary = ~10 minutes/lesson
 Visual Skills = ~10 minutes/lesson

- Select *Use Customised Class Assignments*.
- Enter the number of lessons in Reading, Vocabulary and Visual Skills you want your student to complete each week.
- Click **Save**.

Tip

We recommend you use customised class assignments set at 5 Reading Lessons and 1 Vocabulary lesson. This ties in with our usage recommendations of 3 x 30-minute sessions per week with the primary focus on reading.

Approximate Completion Times per Lesson:

- **Reading** = ~15 minutes/lesson
- **Vocabulary** = ~10 minutes/lesson
- **Visual Skills** = ~10 minutes/lesson
