REPORT OVERVIEW

The **Student Assessment Report** displays data for each administration of InSight. Use this report to view a student's baseline skill and motivation levels, and to analyse individual student growth over time. 

Note the student's Comprehension Level and Vocabulary Level at each point of assessment.

Proficiency Level is a composite measure of comprehension, vocabulary, and silent reading rate.
