


Student Skills Summary Report

Teachers can use the Student Skills Summary Report to analyse a student's relative strengths and weaknesses across the nine Anchor Skills, track skill development, and identify skills that could benefit from additional instruction and support. Data is presented for every reading level on which the student has worked and provides insight into an individual student's performance with the nine comprehension Anchor Skills.

By default, data represents student performance on all lessons within all reading levels on which the student has worked.

Use the Time Period filter to change the view.

View the various reading levels on which the student has worked.

When students first begin working in the reading component, they complete a Start-Up process of no more than five reading lessons. This process helps to ensure the student is placed on the correct reading level.

Click Correct/Exposures to view the data as the number of correctly answered questions out of all exposures to questions of that type.

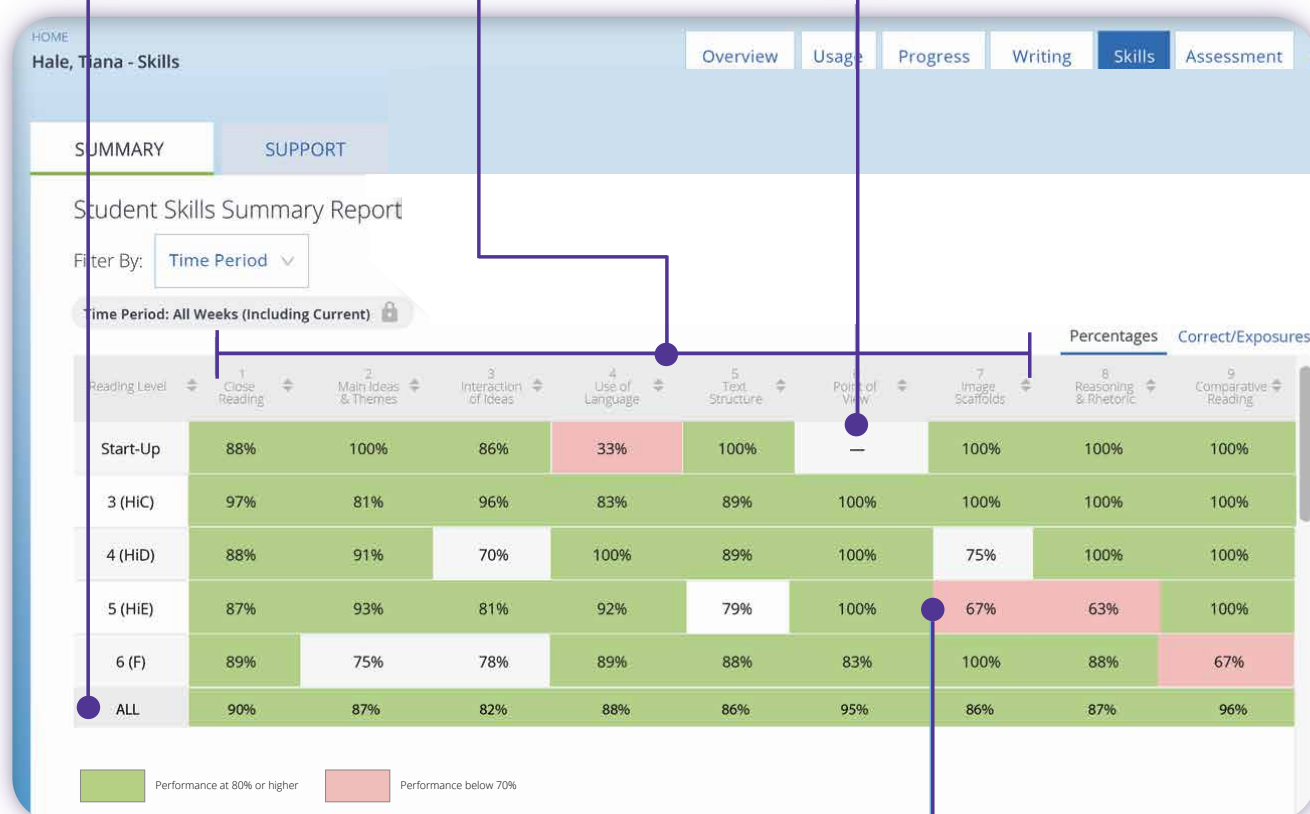
Student Skills Summary Report

View the ALL row to identify the average total percentage for each Anchor Skill, across all reading levels.

Each column is labeled with a comprehension Anchor Skill.

Every Anchor Skill contains multiple comprehension subskills.

A dash is displayed if the student was not exposed to questions of that type on a given level. You may see multiple dashes on a student's current level, if the student recently leveled up and has not yet completed many lessons on the new level.



Green indicates a comprehension Anchor Skill with an average performance at or above 80%.



Red indicates an Anchor Skill with an average performance percentage below 70%.

Average performance percentages between 70% - 79% are not colour-coded.
